

Membership requirements are as follows:

- A. Women who in the opinion of the membership of *Rho Lambda* have displayed outstanding leadership, ability, and loyalty throughout their years of sorority affiliation shall be eligible for membership.
- B. Nominations for membership may be submitted to the current members of *Rho Lambda*, by the president, and the local advisors of each national sorority.
- C. An overall grade point average of a 2.50 (on a 4.0 scale) is required for membership.
- D. Only active members in their junior or senior year are eligible. They must have been initiated, active members of their sorority for at least two full academic terms or semesters.
- E. A transfer student will be eligible for membership after one term or semester on the university or college campus.
- F. A candidate must be a regularly enrolled, full-time undergraduate student in the university.
- G. The maximum number of members to be elected in any year is 10% of the total Panhellenic membership.
- H. Honorary members shall have demonstrated outstanding service to the sorority system but need not have been a sorority woman.
- I. Honorary members shall have all the privileges of membership with the exception of voting.
